Will have a 6 or 7 stage event, approximately 175 rds. STARTING AT 9:00 AM WITH THE SHOOTERS MEETING AND SHOOTING STARTING AT 9:30 AM.

Shooters wishing to shoot in their duty gear may do so, but you must be dressed as you are on duty (no mix). Every one else dress as you please

1. All holsters must cover the trigger guard.
2. Minimum caliber is 9mm.
3. You will need a minimum of 4 magazine pouches (Those shooting low round mags should have 5).
4. All holster belts must pass thru at least 3 belt loops
5. Dress cool and comfortable.

For female officers who have children duties over the week end, come on and shoot we will have a free child care service run by police officers wives to watch your children or child. Check in Sat morning at the training building with your child or children.

Squads will be up to 10 shooters, we will try and squad same Dept, or friends together if possible. TEAMS are allowed. Advise the sign up staff of your team and member names.

Suggest you bring extra ammo for re – shoots , extra shots at steel or targets ect
